

PC Web Viewing Instructions

- Firefox is the preferred browser for viewing your StallWatch cameras.
- First, you must have the latest version of Java installed on your computer. To verify, please visit <http://www.java.com/en/download/testjava.jsp>
- Install Java and enable it for your browser*
- After successfully installing/verifying Java, go to:

- Once logged in, click on the icon above that will give a 4x4 view. There is a button to increase the size. I usually set to 320x240 for a laptop. To view the cameras, drag and drop each camera one at a time into each video window. You will click and drag from the list at the far left and drop onto the empty video window on the right. The first time, you will have to "allow" Java to run and it may ask you to re-enter the username and password - this will only happen the first time you setup the view. If the page becomes un-responsive, it is usually caused by a java pop-up window that is not seen asking for permissions. Look for the pop-up window and click "allow."
- To view a single camera full screen, double click directly on the camera window. Right click on a window to quickly do a review (called "search") of the last 30 seconds to ten minutes. You can also search for any time on any camera to review and playback at various speeds up. Clips may also be downloaded to your computer..
